REGULATIONS

on the International Student Olympiad "RUDN MathOlymp" of the Federal State Autonomous Educational Institution of Higher Education «Peoples' Friendship University of Russia named after Patrice Lumumba»

1. General

- 1.1. These Regulations on the International Student Olympiad "RUDN Matholymp" of the Federal State Autonomous Educational Institution of Higher Education "Peoples' Friendship University of Russia named after Patrice Lumumba" (hereinafter referred to as the Regulations; Olympiad; RUDN University, University) were developed in accordance with the Federal Law of the Russian Federation dated December 29, 2012 No. 273-FZ "On Education in the Russian Federation" and the RUDN University Charter.
- 1.2. The regulations determine the goals and objectives of the Olympiad, its organizational and methodological support, conditions for participation, as well as the procedure for organizing and announcing the winners of the Olympiad.
- 1.3. The organizer of the Olympiad is the RUDN University.
- 1.4. The Olympiad is held by RUDN University annually.
- 1.5. Every year, no later than a month before the start date of the Olympiad, the Organizing Committee of the Olympiad ensures approval in the prescribed manner of the Procedure for the conduct of the Olympiad for the corresponding academic year (hereinafter referred to as the Procedure), which establishes the timing of the Olympiad, the procedure for registering participants in the Olympiad, the procedure for conducting each round of the Olympiad, the procedure of consideration of appeals, and the procedure for determining the winners of the Olympiad.

In the 2024/2025 academic year, the Procedure is approved simultaneously with these Regulations.

- 1.6. The Olympiad is held with the aim of identifying talented young people and stimulating their interest in mathematics in scientific and professional terms.
- 1.7. The main goals of the Olympiad are:
 - a) creating the necessary conditions to support gifted young people and encouragement to continue educational and scientific activities;
 - b) increasing the prestige of the RUDN University in the Russian and international arenas in the field of "Mathematics", as well as the development of the RUDN University Olympiad movement.
- 1.8. The Olympiad is held in the subject "Mathematics".
- 1.9. Financial support for the Olympiad is carried out at the expense of the RUDN University's funds received from income-generating activities.
- 1.10. These Regulations, amendments, and additions to it are approved by order of the rector of RUDN University.

2. Organizational and methodological support of the Olympiad

- 2.1. For organizational and methodological support of the Olympiad, the governing bodies of the Olympiad are created:
 - a) Organizing Committee of the Olympiad;
 - b) Jury of the Olympiad.
- 2.2. The composition of the Organizing Committee is approved annually by order of the rector of RUDN University no later than 2 months before the start of the Olympiad. In the 2024/2025 academic year, the composition of the Organizing Committee is approved simultaneously with these Regulations.
- 2.3. Organizing Committee of the Olympiad:
 - carries out the general organization of the Olympiad;
 - approves the composition and coordinates the work of the Jury;
 - develops and approves Olympiad tasks and verification criteria;
 - ensures approval of the Olympiad regulations;
 - approves the schedule of the Olympiad;
 - provides equal conditions for participation for persons with disabilities;
 - provides informational coverage of the Olympiad;
 - attracts sponsors to finance the Olympiad.
- 2.4. Jury of the Olympiad:
 - checks and evaluates the work of Olympiad participants;
 - considers appeals of Olympiad participants based on applications submitted to the Organizing Committee.
- 2.5. In order to provide a unified information space for Olympiad participants, an Olympiad website is being created, the information on which is updated annually by the Student Admissions Department of the RUDN University in accordance with regulatory documents for the current year. A single e-mail address math_olymp@rudn.ru is also created to resolve organizational and other issues with the participants of the Olympiad.
- 2.6. In order to promote and popularize the Olympiad, as well as attract interested students in undergraduate and specialty programs to participate in the Olympiad, the Organizing Committee annually conducts an advertising campaign with the involvement of the necessary departments of the RUDN University.
- 2.7. Advertising information, notification of the start of the Olympiad and regulatory documents are published annually on the official website of the Olympiad, on social

networks and through other available information resources in the public domain.

3. Conditions for participation in the Olympiad

- 3.1. The conditions for the Olympiad are equal for all participants.
- 3.2. In the case of participation in the Olympics by persons with disabilities, the organizers of the Olympiad, if possible, create special conditions to ensure their equal participation in the Olympiad.
- 3.3. Students of 1-4 years of educational programs of higher education bachelor's and specialty programs of state and non-state educational organizations of higher education of the Russian Federation and foreign countries (hereinafter referred to as participants) are allowed to participate in the Olympiad.
- 3.4. To participate in the Olympiad, registration in the manner prescribed by the Procedure is mandatory.
- 3.5. To participate in the Olympiad, it is necessary to have a group leader from each educational organization whose students apply for participation.
- 3.4.1. The group leader can be an employee of an educational organization or a student in a postgraduate program in this organization;
- 3.6. There is no registration fee for participation in the Competition.

4. Procedure for organizing the Olympiad

- 4.1. The procedure, timing of the Olympiad, and the procedure for filing appeals are approved annually by the Regulations of the Olympiad and are brought to the attention of participants by publishing information on the official website of the Olympiad.
- 4.2. The procedure of organizing is approved in the manner established by RUDN University no later than a month before the start of the event and is posted on the official website of RUDN University www.rudn.ru.
- 4.3. The working languages of the Olympiad are Russian and English. During registration, participants have the right to choose one of the working languages of the Olympiad to solve problems and pass other tests within the framework of the Olympiad.
- 4.4. The Olympiad is held in a mixed format: in the direct presence of Olympiad participants or remotely. The order for conducting a specific round of the Olympics is established by the Procedure.
- 4.5. The Olympiad will include individual and team rounds. Based on the results of each

round, the Jury determines the winners of the Olympiad by generating rating lists with the results of the participants.

5. Announcement of winners

- 5.1. The lists of winners are approved by the protocol of the Organizing Committee meeting according to the decision of the Jury. After approval, the lists are published on the official website of the Olympiad.
- 5.2. Based on the results of the Olympiad, the winners are awarded cash prizes and diplomas indicating their status:
 - 1st degree winner diploma;
 - 2nd degree winner diploma;
 - 3rd degree winner diploma.

The amounts of payments to the winners of the Olympiad are approved annually by the Olympiad Procedure.

All other participants of the Olympiad, not related to those specified in clause 5.2. of these Regulations, are awarded certificates of participation in the Olympiad.
